8AM - Step aboard the Grand Canyon Railway for a trip to the magnificent Grand Canyon. Relax as the train travels across 65 miles of beautiful Arizona country, with pine forests, high desert plains and small canyons. Strolling musicians and western characters combine to recreate train travel as it was at the turn-of-the-century. Enjoy 3 hours in the Grand Canyon to have lunch, shop, or tour. At 33oP, board the train for the return journey back to Williams. Purchase dinner in Williams.
